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Foreword

This book was submitted as a PhD dissertation to the University of Hamburg in December 2019. It was defended by me in the Summer of the following year. The manuscript takes account of the law as of December 2019, so that the discussion is based on the law previous to the coming into force of the reform of the Japanese civil code (*Minpō*) on 1 April 2020. Nevertheless, the new Japanese rules pertinent to the formation of contracts are included in the analysis.

This comparative study was elaborated during my time as a Research Associate in the Japan Unit of the Max Planck Institute for Comparative and International Private Law in Hamburg, Germany. I am deeply grateful to Professor Dr Harald Baum, who supervised my PhD dissertation patiently and offered his kind guidance and numerous helpful suggestions during this time.
